A NATIONWIDE CALL TO TOLL THE BELLS RINGING ON JULY 4 AT 12 NOON LOCAL TIME.

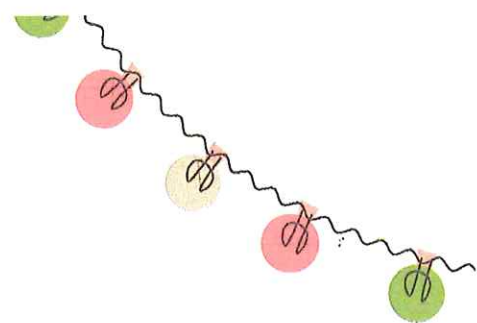
