<u>DEADLINE APPROACHING - 2024-25 PROPERTY TAX AND RENT REBATE</u> PROGRAM APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 30, 2025.

The June 30, 2025 deadline for submission of the District's property tax and rent rebate program for the 2024-25 fiscal year is quickly approaching. The rebate was unanimously approved by the Upper Merion Area School District Board of School Directors in June of 2024. The rebate includes a rebate of up to \$600 for certain homeowners and renters.

To qualify for this discount, applicants must have a household income of no more than \$45,000 annually (half of Social Security income is excluded), and:

- be 65 years of age or older; or
- be a widow or widower aged 50 years of age or older; or
- be permanently disabled and 18 years of age or older.

The property tax and rent rebate program is based on the existing Pennsylvania Property Tax and Rent Rebate program funded by state lottery and gaming proceeds. UMASD homeowners and renters must qualify for the state rebate program to qualify for the district rebate program. The UMASD program is granting qualifying applicants a property tax/ rent rebate of 40 percent of the rebate amount authorized by the Pennsylvania program.

Please note that this year's program is effective on July 1, 2024 based on taxes paid in 2023. 


